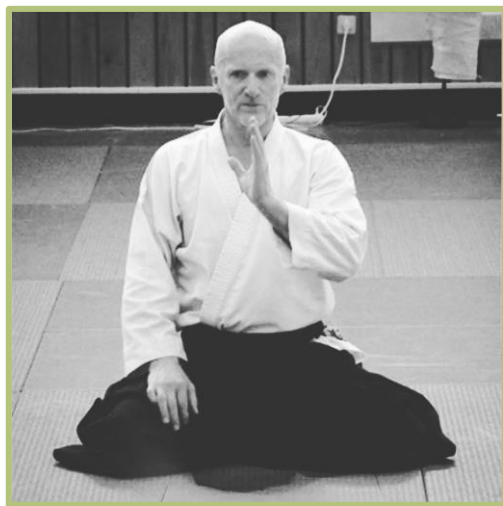

Morito Suganuma Shihan (8th dan) was one of the last Uchideshis of Aikido's founder, Morihei Ueshiba. In 1970 he was sent to Fukuoka by the late Kisshomaru Ueshiba to build up Aikido in Kyushu and Western Japan. Today he is responsible for more than 100 dojos and 4000 students under the umbrella of Shoheijuku. In 2013, the Japan Martial arts Council gave him the "Contributor to the promotion of the Martial arts Award", the most prestigious award in the Japanese Budo world. Suganuma sensei first visited Norway in 1986.

Bjørn Eirik Olsen Shihan (7th dan) started Aikido in Tromsø in 1977. He went to London to practice Aikido full time, followed by many years of intensive practice in Japan. Important teachers have been Morito Suganuma, Minoru Inaba, Minoru Kanetsuka, Seiseki Abe, Morihiro Saito and Kisshomaru Ueshiba. Since 1988 Olsen Sensei has been the chief instructor of the Norwegian Aikido Federation and he also holds regular seminars abroad. Through the Aikido Guide App, his teaching is reaching out to students in 70 countries.
