Sugaruma Sensir was one of the last Unfaderhin of the Founder of Alkido, Morthel Usahiba. In 1970 he was sent to Fukuoka by the late Deshiba to build up Alkido in Nyushu and Western Japan. Due to his great Budo knowledge and understanding of Japanese culture – as well as his personality, his work has given outstanding results. Today he is responsible for more than 100 Dojos and 4000 students under the umbrella of Shahejuku.

in 2013, the Japan Martial arts Council gave him the "Contributor to the promotion of the Martial arts Award". This is the most presigious award in the Japanese Budo world. Sugaruma Sensel first visited Norway in 1986, and this year he will teach his 16th summer seminor here.

BJØRN EIRIK OLSEN SHIHAN, 6. DAN AIKIKAI



Bjorn Eirik Sensei started with Aikido in Tromso, 1977. Later, he practiced in London for one year and in Japan for six years, and visited Japan more than 50 times.

Important teachers were Minoru Kanetsuka, Morito Suganuma, Minoru Indba, Morthiro Salto and Selseki Abe, as well as the late Doshu Kishomaru Ueshiba and the present Doshu Moriteru Ueshiba.

Since 1998 he has been the Chief instruction of the Norwegian Aikido Federation. He has also been teaching in England. Greece, Germany, Victinam and USA, and though the Aikido Guide-application, his instruction is now reaching out to Aikido students in 68 countries.
