started aikido in Tromsø in 1977. He went to London to practice aikido full time, followed by many years of intensive practice in Osaka, Fukuoka and Tokyo. Important teachers have been Morito Suganuma, Minoru Inaba, Minoru Kanetsuka, Seiseki Abe, Morihiro Saito, and Kishomaru Ueshiba. Since 1988, Bjørn Eirik Sensei has been the chief instructor of the Norwegian Aikido Federation, and he also holds regular seminars abroad. Through the Aikido Guide App, his teachings are reaching out to students in 70 countries.



Gaute Lambertsen Shidojin (6th Dan)

began training aikido at the University of Oslo in 1991. From 1996, he lived and trained in Japan for 20 years. During 11 of these years, he trained daily at the Hombu Dojo in Tokyo, receiving direct instruction from many of the world's most senior instructors. Particularly important instructors included Doshu Moriteru Ueshiba, Tsuruzo Miyamoto, and Yoko Okamoto. After many years in Japan, he returned to Norway in 2016 and founded Skøyen Aikido in Oslo, where he teaches several times a week.
